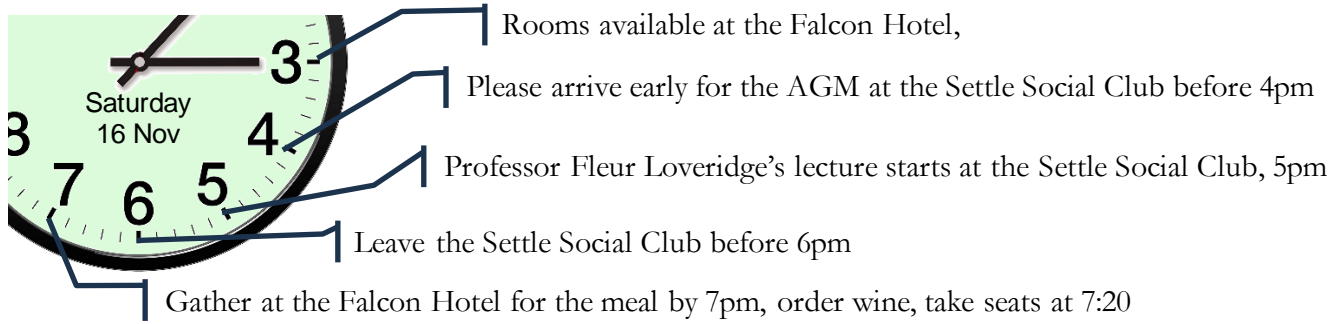

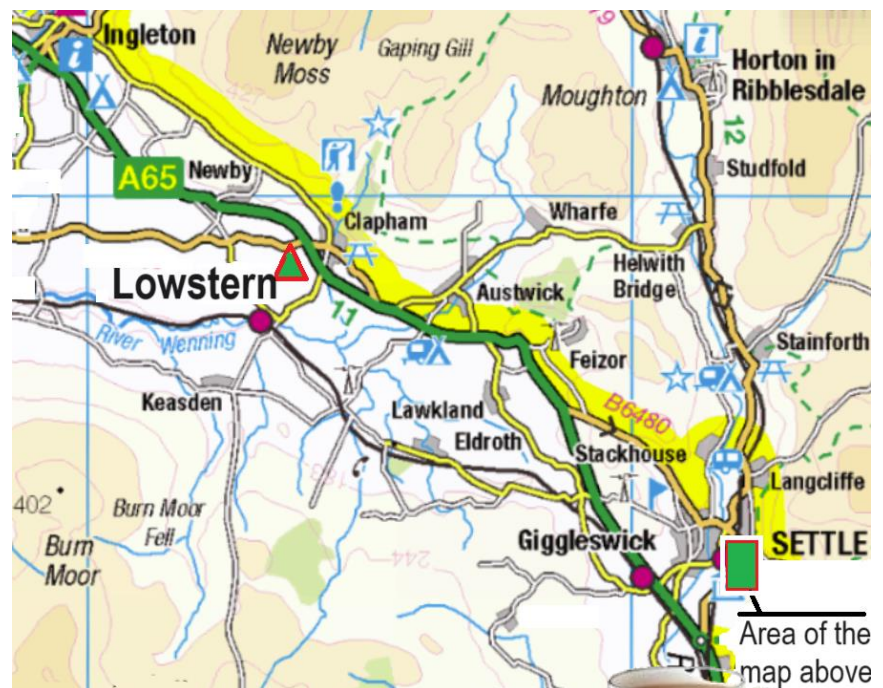
Lowstern is available all weekend.
