Runestone Quarry

OS Ref: NY30650244

Alt: 250m

Gothic ravines and decaying quarry buildings hide this sheltered fast-drying sport venue that offers enjoyable slabs and steep walls catching the morning or afternoon sun. Runestone is easily-

reached and sits hidden in an elevated secluded position, marked by huge spoil heaps, overlooking the Langdale fells.



Ignored for two decades, re-equipping the quarry was started by members of the Eden Valley MC in 2019 and has been continued by a few enthusiastic activists with support from the **Cumbria Bolt Fund.** This hard work, and the publication of this guide, is completed voluntarily and your donations support the purchase of equipment. If you have enjoyed climbing here please make a donation at - **www.cumbriaboltfund.co.uk.**

Warning: The quarry is now a popular venue and traffic has cleaned some of the lines, yet all of these Lakeland slate quarries are unstable with abundant loose material: Take care climbing, moving along the top and across the spoil heaps. The last major rockfall here was as recently as 2021.

Approach

From the A593 Ambleside - Coniston road take the Tilberthwaite turn (acute right if approaching from the north) and park at a large car park below Tilberthwaite Quarry. Walk north along the road passing through the farm. Take the gated bridleway branching up to the left and follow this, steeply at first, for about 1km, until it levels out. To the west, high on the fell, a huge spoil-heap with a conspicuous slate incline marks the way into the quarry. To reach this continue along the bridleway and take the second track on the left; then over a stile to reach the inclined path which leads into the Lower Quarry.

Lower Quarry

TRAD/SPORTUphill 30 min NORTH EAST facing Lat/Lng: 54.412567615807475, -3.0686389844654513

Introduction

A sheltered spot where you may be out of any wind blowing through the Middle Quarry.

Approach

From the ruined buildings at the top of the incline, a loose path descends into the quarry.



Runestone 1 - Lower Quarry - Monster Dog area

West Side

The right-hand side coming down the path from the ruined building. The routes are described clockwise...



Clip the first glue-in bolt then span left to good handholds above the lip and step left into the niche on *Betty Boo*. Mantel onto the slab and traverse left to the arête. Thin cracks in the left side of the slab lead to a short traverse back right.

Up and left onto the slab. From a ledge, step up and left and follow the thin slab.



A really enjoyable romp up the slab left of the descent. Move right across an undercut nose, then trend left to follow a shallow groove.

Start as for *Caspian* and make a rising traverse rightwards, crossing the gully, to the lower off on *Runescape*. Lower down as for *Runescape* to avoid the pit below the overhang.

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



Above the scree slope at the head of the Lower Quarry is a flat area, **The Gallery**. The left wall provides a dozen boulder problems between V1 and V3 which can be identified by the scars. The prominent arête is *Phantom Arête* V3, best approached by the path coming in from the right.

Middle Quarry - East side TRAD/SPORTUphill 30 min NORTH WEST facing ktrl

Introduction

The two faces of Middle Quarry offer contrasting styles:. **The West Face** gets sun in the afternoon and offers a fine varied spread of lines across the grades. Great for an afternoon or evening. **The East Face** sports some of the best routes here on a series of impressively steep walls enjoying morning sun. In the lower (northern) end of the quarry is the cave once used as an illicit whisky still by the notorious Lanty Slee. It was said that the resultant product was the best thing that ever came out of the quarry. **Warning**: there has been significant recent rockfall in Middle Quarry.

Approach


From the entrance to the Lower Quarry, follow the path up the west side of the quarry to reach a flat area between the quarries, from here the Middle Quarry can be seen. The Gallery can be reached from this flat area. On the east side of the quarry is a path which leads under a huge impressive slab bridged across the entrance. *Belly Button Slab* is about 30m up to the left.

The East Face



Upper Entrance Boulder f5+ New 4m

A boulder problem located on the right when entering the Middle Quarry through the arch. Layback the left hand wall; at the grade the left-hand side block is prohibited. Descend over the arch. 8.06.2021 T. Barrett

Still tricky, this start provides a more balanced climb. Make a delicate step left onto the slab above the overhang to join *Clutching* below the upper groove.

Not re-equipped. Climb the slabby corner, then rightwards through tiers of overhangs to a curving overlap. Step left, up to a ledge, then finish more easily. Or, step right with more difficulty, to finish up the rib on the right.





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Upper Quarry

Introduction

Immediately above and south of Middle Quarry and known locally as Tunnel Hole Quarry, quarrying here has only recently been discontinued (2021). Access is by abseil or via a hidden tunnel on its eastern flank. The most prominent feature is a huge arched cave at the southern (uphill) end.

In 2023 a new tenant acquired the tenancy for the quarry above and restarted work there. This has led to liquid waste coming into the Upper Quarry and affecting some of the routes.

The East Face features a long bow-shaped wall of steep slanting grooves ending at a low cave. The climbs typically have difficult lower sections easing with height.

Approach

Follow a path up to the right of Middle Quarry to reach a low wall and follow this then head left up to reach a grassy slope leading to the quarry top. Descend the steep eastern hillside with care, overlooking Hodge Close, to reach some ruined buildings. The tunnel entrance is behind the buildings; initially wet with stepping-stones a drier section then emerges in a low cavern below the right side of the East Face. Abseil: from the anchor at the top of *Whiskey Galore*. This is located on a slab alongside a grassy bay in a distinctive cut in the rim, The Notch, midway along the eastern side.



Runestone 10 Upper Quarry East Face

The East Face

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The first route is on a short wall to the left of the East Face, starting from a prominent large square block leaning against the face.

) Changing of the Guard F6a New 8m

Step off the block traverse rightwards into a shallow groove and climb this on its right side pulling back left to a ledge.

Start 5m lower down to the right of the prominent block, at a slabby groove in an alcove with a horizontal shot hole in left wall. Start easily for a few metres then climb a steep groove and over an overhang to gain a slab. Up this to the anchor.

3) Whiskey Galore F6b+ New 14m

Start at an undercut slab below a line of overhangs at 4m. Move up to undercuts and pull over the overhang to gain a slab. Step up, then tiptoe right on a horizontal shot hole and pull around into a steep slim groove. Climb this over a small overlap and continue, exiting right onto a slab.

Start as for *Whiskey Galore*. Move up to the undercuts then traverse awkwardly right beneath the overhangs to reach a good hold in a groove. Climb the slim slabby groove trending rightwards and pull over onto the slab.

Start on the left-hand side of the wide cavern roof. From some blocks by a low shot hole make a stiff pull up to gain a smaller shot hole, then move right and up to an overlap. Pull straight over to a larger one, turn this on the left then climb a slab and short groove rightwards to the anchor. 12.05.2022 K. Phizacklea



English Summer F7a+ New 16m

From blocks below the left side of the roof boulder the roof to gain a groove and horizontal shot hole. Make awkward moves right to reach better holds (pre-clip the second bolt). Continue up and follow a slim groove, exiting right to a ledge. Move up and over an overhang then rightwards. 29.05.2022 K. Phizacklea




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Runestone 11 Upper Quarry West Face

The West Face

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Right of the huge arched cave at the northern end of the quarry is a distinctive bottomless arête.

White Lightning F7a New 18m

Start below the right corner of a square pillar, just right of the cave. Climb the pillar to overhangs. Pull through rightwards then across a tricky white wall to reach the arête. Follow the thin crack line in the slab trending leftwards above a lot of space to reach the lower offs.

On the West Face right of a line of square cut overhangs is a big left slanting slab.



This excellent route dries very quickly. Start at the base of the slab. Climb easily up to some ledges

then step left and make delicate moves up a thin crack in the slab to reach better holds. Move up and pull leftwards around the arête into a short groove. Climb the middle of the slab to an anchor. 12.05.2022 P.Whillance, K.Phizacklea
