YRC MEETS PROGRAMME

Participate - Lead - Support - Bring A Guest

General Information

Members, their Guests and Prospective Members wishing to attend Meets should book a place using the appropriate Booking Form on the website. The Meet Leader will facilitate car sharing where possible.

Club Meets are usually catered for and the Meet Notice and Booking Form will detail all necessary arrangements including those for meals and refreshments, etc.

Guests

The Club welcomes Guests on Meets provided they are registered with the Membership Secretary to take advantage of three months free BMC Combined Liability Insurance. After three months have elapsed, the Registered Guest must become a Prospective Member to attend <a href="mailto:any-in-the-nature

Participation in Club Meets

Hill-walking, caving, potholing, skiing, climbing and mountaineering like many similar activities, have an element of risk of personal injury or even death. Members and their guests participating in these activities on Club Meets do so voluntarily. Individuals must be aware of and accept these risks, and are responsible for their own actions, involvement and safety at all times.

Club Meets do not provide formally led or guided activities or tuition. If a Club Member or Members decide to accept responsibility for any activity (e.g. taking an individual or a group walking, skiing, climbing, scrambling or mountaineering, caving or exploring mines, etc.) it is on the basis that they are only helping by sharing their experience; they are not in any way qualified; they are not regarded by the Club nor regard themselves as 'technical experts' but are amateur walkers, skiers, climbers, scramblers, mountaineers or cavers etc. with some experience which they are prepared to share.

Any less-experienced Members or Guests accompanying them take any advice on this basis and the onus of responsibility for deciding whether or not to rely on any such advice lies with the less-experienced Member or Guest.

Meet Leader's Role and Responsibilities

The role of the Meet Leader is confined to facilitating the arrangements for the Meet concerning information, accommodation, transport and food. The use of the term "Leader" by the Club carries no implication that the Club considers that the individual is a person who, by training or experience, is necessarily qualified to be a leader in the hills and mountains or in cave systems.

The Meet Leader will undertake or delegate the following administrative responsibilities for the Meet:

- Work with the Meets Secretary to identify and book suitable accommodation, taking into account the facilities, the likely number of participants, possible activities, etc.
- · Liaise with the Treasurer in respect of payment of any up-

front deposit necessary to secure the booking.

- Prepare a Meet Notice ahead of time containing full details
 of the Meet in terms of location, suitable guidebooks/maps,
 transport options, directions and Grid Reference/Sat Nav
 coordinates for accommodation and facilities, communal
 catering arrangements, possible activities/Meet objectives,
 suggested equipment and costs etc.
- Provide the Meets Secretary with the information necessary to produce a website Booking Page.
- Determine food provision on catered Meets entirely at their discretion, including whether or not to accept any requests for alternative dietary requirements.
- Facilitate requests for sharing transport to minimise car use.
- Finalise numbers with accommodation managers and communal catering providers, where necessary.
- Communicate any special requirements for access, parking, or camping etc. on the Meet and making arrangements for obtaining keys, where necessary.
- Comply with the Club rules and guidelines in particular the policy for the protection of the young and vulnerable adults.
- Collect appropriate Meet fees from all participating Members and registered Guests.
- Ensure that arrangements are in place to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and secure.
- Make arrangements for returning the keys, where necessary.
- Provide the Treasurer with a financial account of the Meet and arranging for any transfer of funds.

- Write or delegate the preparation of the Meet Report which is to be forwarded to the Meets Secretary within two weeks of the meet (except for expedition reports, where the timing should be agreed). The Meet Report must include a list of all those attending.
- Assist the Meets Secretary and Committee in finding a replacement Meet Leader should circumstances dictate.

The Committee thanks all Meet Leaders for their efforts and welcomes offers of support and help to run Meets to the YRC's usual high standards. If you would like to run a Meet or have suggestions for a venue please contact the Meet Secretary.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Annual Subscription

The annual subscription for membership of the Club for 2024-5 is £65. Members under twenty-five years of age on 1st November and those in full-time education are entitled to pay only half the full subscription. Life Members over 65 years of age may elect to pay half the full subscription on giving notice to the Treasurer. Members resident overseas pay £45.

YRC Archives

Much of the Club's history is held in a Public Records Office to be maintained and be more accessible for reference under the control of a professional archivist. The material remains the property of the Club. Our Archivist will advise Members from time to time of archival material being deposited and can supply on request a list of material currently held.

The YRC archival material is held at the North Yorkshire County Record Office, Malpas Road, NORTHALLERTON, DL7 8TB. Tel: 01609 777585, e-mail: archives@northyorks.gov.uk. There are useful pages on the North Yorkshire Council web site. The Senior Archivist is Tom Richardson.

It is a five minute walk from County Hall, the railway station and the town centre car park. The A1 & A19 are a few miles distant. Staff will be pleased to give directions and the YRC Archivist can provide a location map on request. The facilities include: large public search room, internet access, WiFi hotspot, tea room for visitors' use, and toilets. There is no charge to visit the Record Office.

Please make an appointment before visiting. Bookings can be made by telephone, by e-mail, by fax, by post or in person. Original items must be ordered in advance and fees are charged for copies.

British Mountaineering Council

The Club is affiliated to the BMC which represents the interests of climbers and mountaineers at both local and national level. Affiliation to the BMC provides all UK resident Members of the YRC with indemnity insurance against civil liability claims while undertaking climbing, mountaineering and abseiling as well as scrambling and mountain walking. UK resident Members will receive copies of Summit magazine. YRC Members can upgrade to full individual membership of the BMC with additional benefits. The British Caving Association (BCA)

The Club is an Associate Member of the BCA. This organisation fulfils for caving and potholing what the BMC does for mountaineering and fell walking, and is recognised by the UK Sports Council as the governing body for caving in Great Britain. It is a federation of Regional Caving Councils, national bodies with specialist interests, caving clubs and individual members.

For many years the Club has been a member of the Council of Northern Caving Clubs (CNCC), one of the main functions of which has been to negotiate agreements with landowners to permit access by caving clubs to caves on private land. In particular, it organised permits to control access by cavers to the Leck Fell area, which includes the Easegill system, the longest system of cave passages in the UK. The CNCC is now subsumed into the BCA structure

As an Associate Member of the BCA, the Club also becomes a member of the British Cave Research Association (BCRA), which is a charitable organisation aimed at promoting the study of caves and karst by encouraging the exploration of caves both in the UK and overseas.

Like the BMC, the BCA also operates a Public Liability (PL) scheme. However, unlike the situation with the BMC, PL cover is not a compulsory component of BCA Membership and at present the YRC has opted out of this.

YRC Library

The Club's Library is held at Lowstern in the Library Room. The Library is kept locked for insurance reasons. Members can purchase Library keys for £10 from the Huts Booking Secretary, which remain the property of the Club. (If lost, a further key will cost £10).

You can browse; or to borrow a book, enter details in the Borrowing Book: when you return it, record the return. Please take care to return each book to its coded position. To borrow by post: ask the Librarian. When returning: enclose sufficient stamps to cover the outward postage.

The catalogue is held on the computer in the Library: Full user's guide instructions are provided. The catalogue lists over 1200 books, excluding journals, by their shelf position. Instructions for finding books by *author* (e.g. all

books by FS Smythe) are provided. Listing by *categories* is in hand i.e. Mountaineering; Archaeology, History & Science; Caving & Potholing; Guides; Journals; Periodicals & Society Publications; Skiing; Walking & Trekking; etc.

Material from Bequests

Material from bequests falls into several categories:

- Books the YRC Librarian is pleased to receive books about mountaineering and/or caving which are of particular value for the history of the sport, or involve members of the YRC.
 Books on other subjects, or more general books on mountaineering/caving, should be offered elsewhere. If in doubt, contact the Librarian.
- Papers the YRC Archivist is pleased to receive original research and original correspondence, plus any very early papers – say pre-1960. Meet and other reports and circulars, minutes etc are already well-represented in the archive, and further copies are not needed. If in doubt, contact the Archivist
- Maps unless of particular interest and relevance for the archive, maps should be offered elsewhere.
- Journals, handbooks, dinner menus and other memorabilia we have enough journals, handbooks and YRC dinner menus – other memorabilia MAY be useful, please discuss with the Archivist.
- Photographs may be of interest for the archive but ONLY if relevant to the YRC and ONLY if they come with information about who and/or what is on them. This is especially true for digital images, of which we all have too many! If in doubt, contact the Archivist.

It would be ideal if Members followed this advice and sorted out potential bequests themselves in good time rather than leaving it to families or friends.

Members are also reminded that if they have an interest in acquiring bound sets of YRC journals or any specific volumes that get donated to the club they should register their interest with the Librarian

Mailings are published at least quarterly and contain information on Club activities and news, as well as details of forthcoming Meets. These are sent out by e-mail and are available on the website; members without access to e-mail will continue to receive copies by post.

Journals

The full colour Club Journal is published once a year and all members are encouraged to submit articles to the Editor.

Potholing Tackle

The Club's tackle is housed in a locked tackle store at Lowstern. Members wishing to use the tackle may do so. Members may have their own key to the tackle store, obtainable from the Tacklemaster. All keys, which remain the

property of the Club, will be provided against a returnable deposit of £10 per key. (If lost, a further key will cost £10).

After use, tackle must be returned immediately to the store in a clean state, with the ropes uncoiled to facilitate drying. There is a tap in the external wall and water-wash brush for cleaning ropes. Members must advise the Tacklemaster if any tackle is lost or damaged.

Prospective Membership

Prospective Members: PMs are welcomed and will receive Club mailings for a year only unless re-requested. Prospective members have no other privileges. A membership fee may be payable to become a BMC Club Member.

Junior Prospective Members: Members should provide the Membership Secretary with the names of their children or grandchildren under the age of 18 who they wish to become JPMs. A membership fee may be payable to become a BMC Club Family Member.

Rules

On joining, all Members will be provided with a copy of the Rules and Bye-laws of the Club and agree to be bound by them and do nothing which is contrary to, or in conflict with, the aims of the Club.

Members using Club Huts must, as a matter of duty of care, make themselves and any Guests aware of the fire and safety systems. Hut Handbooks are available on site and on-line.

LOWSTERN

Post Code: LA2 8HL (NB DO NOT USE WITH A SAT NAV)

Location: OS SD 7366 6905

Situation: In a small plantation, through gates, on the south side of the B6480 Clapham-Bentham Road, 400m SW of the junction with the A65 Clapham by-pass. Ample parking. Food supplies: Clapham, Austwick, Ingleton and Settle.

Fuel: There is an open fire in the living room (logs supplied for Members use only) and gas for heaters, showers, and cooking. Electricity for lighting, microwave ovens, refrigerators and dehumidifier.

Accommodation: 16 (excluding 6 places in the room reserved for YRC Members). Camping allowed.

IOW HALL GARTH

Post Code: LA22 9NT Location: OS NY 3096 0289

Situation: Low Hall Garth is an old farmstead cottage owned by the National Trust and leased to the YRC. It is situated above Little Langdale Tarn in a delightful and secluded position. Off A593 Ambleside-Coniston, south of Skelwith Bridge. At 0.4 miles south of the Elterwater-Langdales junction, turn-off west with two lanes: fork right - NT sign to Hallgarth.

Go for 1.6 miles passing farm buildings. At the ford (not fit for

vehicles), turn left alongside the beck and through a gate. At Low Hall Garth, the hut is round the corner with 'YRC' on the door. Park up the hill, in the centre between marker slates. Maximum of 4 vehicles may be parked at LHG as per our lease. (NB a locked bollarded NT parking space for 3-4 cars near the ford may be available - contact the Hut Warden).

Open fireplace and stove: bring your own wood or smokeless fuel. Well equipped kitchen with electric cookers, microwave, refrigerators. Washroom, toilets and shower. Drying room. Large comfortable stove-heated sitting room in barn opposite. *Accommodation*: 12, in bunks in one dormitory. Middle and top bunks are not suitable for young children. The 4 bunks in the barn are reserved for YRC members. Camping is not allowed.

It is very important that users of the hut take care not to disturb people in the NT cottage above. Between 10.30 pm and 7.00 am, please keep voices down especially in the dormitory and kitchen and don't rattle pans etc.

Club Hut Fees for Lowstern and Low Hall Garth

'Members' are YRC Members and their families.

'Family' is defined as direct line, i.e. a Member's parents and grandparents, children and grandchildren and their spouses or equivalent.

'Kindred' are Members of nominated Kindred Clubs.

'Others' are YRC Prospective Members, all Guests and others. YRC Members £6.00, Proposed Members £6.00, Prospective Members £14.00, Kindred Club Members £10, Others £14.00. Children under 5: free; 5-15: £5.00; 16 and over: adult fee. *Groups*: For other users as a group, there is a £150 deposit for

weekend bookings. £150 minimum weekend charge (Friday/ Saturday nights).

Club Hut and Library Keys

Members may have their own key to the Club's Huts (one key services both Huts) and the Library at Lowstern which may be obtained from the Huts Booking Secretary. All keys, which remain the property of the Club, will be provided against a returnable deposit of £10 per key. (If lost, a further key will cost £10).

Members must not under any circumstances lend a key to a non-member not present with them.

Each hut has a key in a key safe accessed by a combination lock. The code is changed regularly. If members need to use these they should consult the Members-only section of the website (or contact the Huts Booking Secretary or relevant Hut Warden) for the current code.

Club Hut Bookings

A calendar of bookings is available on the relevant Hut webpage and is regularly updated. Members are encouraged to log-in and use the online hut booking form when planning to use one of the huts and book member's-only beds. Your own Hut bookings may be checked and edited online from the "Your Hut Bookings" page in the Members area.

Hut fees should preferably be paid by BACS transfer to the YRC Hut Account No. 72005688 Sort Code 53-70-00 with an e-mail to the Huts Secretary giving dates of stay and number of bed-nights in each category.

HUTS OF KINDRED CLUBS

Inter-Club Arrangements

Reciprocal rights arrangements have been made for YRC Members to use huts owned by Kindred Clubs and for their members to use Low Hall Garth and Lowstern. The fees payable by YRC Members will be those stated by the Club owners. New arrangements have been agreed between the YRC and the Climbers' Club (Helyg and R.O. Downes huts); the Wayfarers' Club (Robertson Lamb Hut); the FRCC (all huts); and Scottish Mountaineering Club (all huts) to simplify booking, access and hut fee payments for all club members. ¾ mile short of Wasdale Hall Farm (approaching from the main road) at the foot of Lingmell Gill junction with Burnmoor track.

Accom: 8 men, 8 women, 12 mixed + camping.

1 mile beyond Buttermere Village towards Gatesgarth Farm on the Hassness Estate between the road and the lake.

Accom: Hut 19 men, 14 women; Cottage 8 mixed in 2 rooms; Coach House 13 mixed in 3 rooms.
